4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion

: If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately

: Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the Eyelids, for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses. Immediate medical attention is required

Skin

: Take off all contaminated clothing immediately. Wash off immediately with plenty of water. If skin irritation persists, call a doctor. Wash contaminated clothing

Inhalation

: Remove to fresh air. If breathing is irregular or stopped, administer artificial respiration. Keep patient warm and at rest. Call a doctor or Poison Information Centre immediately

Advice to Physician

1. Atropinize the patient immediately and maintain full atropinization by repeated doses of 2 to 4 mg. at 5 to 10 minutes interval for



hours together. The need for further atropine administration is indicated by the continuance of symptoms. As much as 25 to 50 mg. may be required in a day. The extent to salivation is a useful criterion to follow in adjusting the dosage of atropine.

2. 1-2 gm 2 PAM dissolved in 10CC distilled water and is injected intravenously very slowly for 10-15 minutes.

In Case of Emergency

- : In case of spillage it is important to take all steps necessary to
 - Avoid eye and skin contact
 - Avoid contamination of waterways Wear full length clothing and PVC gloves, Keep all bystanders away

Clean up Procedures

- : Procedure for spill
 - (1) Keep all bystanders away
 - (2) Wear full length clothing and PVC gloves
 - (3) Reposition any leaking containers so as to minimise further leakage
 - (4) Dam and absorb spill with an absorbent material (e.g. sand or soil)

- (5) Shovel the absorbed spill into drums
- (6) Disposal of the absorbed material will depend upon the extent of the spill
- For quantities up to 50 L of product bury in a secure landfill site

- (7) Decontaminate spill area with detergent and water and rinse with the smallest volume of water practicable
